- join Dance Marathon


- go on a Hawkeye Service Break trip during spring break,



- lowa GROW® (Guided Reflection on Work) makes student employment a "high-impact activity" that requires students to reflect on their learning and connect their learning within and beyond the classroom.
- GROW® participants are retained at 7-15 points higher than non-GROW® participants
